DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 95/2003

of 11 July 2003

amending Annex XXI (Statistics) to the EEA Agreement

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, as amended by the Protocol adjusting the Agreement on the European Economic Area, hereinafter referred to as 'the Agreement', and in particular Article 98 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Annex XXI to the Agreement was amended by Decision of the EEA Joint Committee No 62/2003 of 16 May 2003¹.
- (2) Commission Regulation (EC) No 246/2003 of 10 February 2003 adopting the programme of ad hoc modules, covering the years 2004 to 2006, to the labour force sample survey provided by Council Regulation (EC) No 577/98² is to be incorporated into the Agreement,
- (3) This decision is not to apply to Liechtenstein.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The following point shall be inserted after point 18ac (Commission Regulation (EC) No 2104/2002 of Annex XXI to the Agreement:

'18ad. **32003 R 0246**: Commission Regulation (EC) No 246/2003 of 10 February 2003 adopting the programme of ad hoc modules, covering the years 2004 to 2006, to the labour force sample survey provided by Council Regulation (EC) No 577/98 (OJ L 34, 11.2.2003, p. 3).

The provisions of the Regulation shall, for the purposes of the present Agreement, be read with the following adaptations:

- (a) This Regulation shall not apply to Liechtenstein.
- (b) Norway shall provide the information required by this Regulation at the latest as from 2005.'

Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on 12 July 2003, provided that all the notifications under Article 103(1) of the Agreement have been made to the EEA Joint Committee*.

Article 4

This Decision shall be published in the EEA Section of, and in the EEA Supplement to, the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
