

## DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE

No 128/2012

of 13 July 2012

## amending Annex XI (Electronic communication, audiovisual services and information society) to the EEA Agreement

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, as amended by the Protocol adjusting the Agreement on the European Economic Area, hereinafter referred to as 'the Agreement', and in particular Article 98 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Annex XI to the Agreement was amended by Decision of the EEA Joint Committee No 109/2012 of 15 June 2012 <sup>(1)</sup>.
- (2) Commission Decision 2010/267/EU of 6 May 2010 on harmonised technical conditions of use in the 790-862 MHz frequency band for terrestrial systems capable of providing electronic communications services in the European Union <sup>(2)</sup> is to be incorporated into the Agreement,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

The following point shall be inserted after point 5czg (Commission Decision 2010/166/EU) of Annex XI to the Agreement:

'5czh. **32010 D 0267**: Commission Decision 2010/267/EU of 6 May 2010 on harmonised technical conditions of use in the 790-862 MHz frequency band for

terrestrial systems capable of providing electronic communications services in the European Union (OJ L 117, 11.5.2010, p. 95).'

*Article 2*

The text of Decision 2010/267/EU in the Icelandic and Norwegian languages, to be published in the EEA Supplement to the *Official Journal of the European Union*, shall be authentic.

*Article 3*

This Decision shall enter into force on 14 July 2012, provided that all the notifications under Article 103(1) of the Agreement have been made to the EEA Joint Committee (\*).

*Article 4*

This Decision shall be published in the EEA Section of, and in the EEA Supplement to, the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
