# DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 174/2019 of 14 June 2019

## amending Annex XX (Environment) to the EEA Agreement [2022/2166]

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area ("the EEA Agreement"), and in particular Article 98 thereof,

# Whereas:

- (4) Annex XX to the EEA Agreement should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:
