# amending Annex XI (Electronic communication, audiovisual services and information society) to the EEA Agreement [2015/1258]

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area ('the EEA Agreement'), and in particular Article 98 thereof,

#### Whereas:

- Commission Implementing Decision 2013/752/EU of 11 December 2013 amending Decision 2006/771/EC on harmonisation of the radio spectrum for use by short-range devices and repealing Decision 2005/928/EC (1) is to be incorporated into the EEA Agreement.
- Implementing Decision 2013/752/EU repeals Commission Decision 2005/928/EC (2), which is incorporated into (2) the EEA Agreement and which is consequently to be repealed under the EEA Agreement.
- (3)Annex XI to the EEA Agreement should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

#### Article 1

Annex XI to the EEA Agreement shall be amended as follows:

- (1) the following indent is added in point 5cz (Commission Decision 2006/771/EC):
  - '— 32013 D 0752: Commission Implementing Decision 2013/752/EU of 11 December 2013 (OJ L 334, 13.12.2013, p. 17).';
- (2) the text of point 5ct (Commission Decision 2005/928/EC) is deleted.

### Article 2

The text of Implementing Decision 2013/752/EU in the Icelandic and Norwegian languages, to be published in the EEA Supplement to the Official Journal of the European Union, shall be authentic.

# Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on 26 September 2014, provided that all the notifications under Article 103(1) of the EEA Agreement have been made (\*).

### Article 4

This Decision shall be published in the EEA Section of, and in the EEA Supplement to, the Official Journal of the European Union.
