Arrangement on Trade in Agricultural Products between Egypt and Iceland

ARTICLE 1

This Arrangement between Egypt and Iceland on trade in agricultural products is concluded pursuant to the Free Trade Agreement between Egypt and the EFTA States of 2007 (hereinafter referred to as "the Free Trade Agreement"), and in particular Article 4 thereof. It forms part of the instruments establishing a free trade area between the EFTA States and Egypt.

ARTICLE 2

Egypt shall grant tariff concessions to agricultural products originating in Iceland as specified in Annex 1 to this Arrangement. Iceland shall grant tariff concessions to agricultural products originating in Egypt as specified in Annex 2 to this Arrangement.

ARTICLE 3

The following provisions of the Free Trade Agreement shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to this Arrangement: Articles 5 (Rules of origin and co-operation in customs administration), 9 (Quantitative restrictions and measures having equivalent effect, 10 (Customs duties and quantitative restrictions on exports), 11 (Internal taxation), 12 (Payments and transfers), 15 (State trading enterprises) and 21 (General exceptions) of Chapter Trade in Goods.

ARTICLE 4

The Parties confirm their rights and obligations under the WTO Agreement on Agriculture.

ARTICLE 5

The rights and obligations of the Parties in respect of sanitary and phytosanitary measures shall be governed by the WTO Agreement on Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures.

ARTICLE 6

- 1. The Parties undertake to continue their efforts with a view to achieving further liberalization of their agricultural trade, within the framework of their respective agricultural policies.
- 2. The first review shall take place no later than four years after the entry into force of this Agreement, with further reviews to be determined at the first review.

ARTICLE 7

This Arrangement shall enter into force on the same date as the Free Trade Agreement enters into force between Egypt and Iceland. It shall remain in force as long as the Parties to it remain Parties to the Free Trade Agreement between Egypt and the EFTA States.

ARTICLE 8

If Iceland or Egypt withdraws from this Arrangement, the Free Trade Agreement shall terminate between them on the same date as the withdrawal from this Arrangement becomes effective.

ARTICLE 9

The Annexes to this Arrangement constitute an integral part of it.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, being duly authorised thereto, have signed this Arrangement.

Done at Davos, this 27th day of January 2007 in two originals in the Arabic and English languages, both being equally authentic. In case of any divergence in the interpretation of this Agreement, the English text shall prevail.
