## EEA EFTA Comment on the

Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on aviation security charges (COM (2009) 217)

The EEA EFTA States, Iceland, Liechtenstein, and Norway, have studied with great interest the Commission's Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on aviation security charges (COM (2009) 217), and appreciate the opportunity to comment on the draft Directive. The main views of the EEA EFTA States are the following:

The EEA EFTA States would like to stress that they support the Commission's proposal for a new directive on aviation security charges where the Member States are left free to decide themselves how to finance security measures going beyond the requirements stipulated by EU legislation.

As a consequence, the EEA EFTA States do not favour a possible amendment by the European Parliament to the Commission proposal which would oblige Member States to finance from state resources the costs of stricter measures under Article 6 of Regulation (EC) 300/2008 or any other extra measures.
