

## DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE

No 92/2012

of 30 April 2012

## amending Annex VI (Social security) to the EEA Agreement

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, as amended by the Protocol adjusting the Agreement on the European Economic Area, hereinafter referred to as 'the Agreement', and in particular Article 98 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Annex VI to the Agreement was amended by Decision of the EEA Joint Committee No 18/2012 of 10 February 2012 <sup>(1)</sup>.
- (2) Decision No H6 of 16 December 2010 concerning the application of certain principles regarding the aggregation of periods under Article 6 of Regulation (EC) No 883/2004 on the coordination of social security systems <sup>(2)</sup> is to be incorporated into the Agreement,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

The following point shall be inserted after point 6.5 (Decision No H5) of Annex VI to the Agreement:

- '6.6. **32011 D 0212(01)**: Decision No H6 of 16 December 2010 concerning the application of certain principles

regarding the aggregation of periods under Article 6 of Regulation (EC) No 883/2004 on the coordination of social security systems (OJ C 45, 12.2.2011, p. 5).'

*Article 2*

The text of Decision No H6 in the Icelandic and Norwegian languages, to be published in the EEA Supplement to the *Official Journal of the European Union*, shall be authentic.

*Article 3*

This Decision shall enter into force on 1 May 2012, provided that all the notifications under Article 103(1) of the Agreement have been made to the EEA Joint Committee (\*), or on the day of the entry into force of Decision of the EEA Joint Committee No 76/2011 of 1 July 2011 <sup>(3)</sup>, whichever is the later.

*Article 4*

This Decision shall be published in the EEA Section of, and in the EEA Supplement to, the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
