

**DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 182/2019****of 14 June 2019****amending Protocol 31 to the EEA Agreement, on cooperation in specific fields outside the four freedoms [2022/2174]**

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area (“the EEA Agreement”), and in particular Articles 86 and 98 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) It is appropriate to extend the cooperation of the Contracting Parties to include Regulation (EU) 2019/499 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 March 2019 laying down provisions for the continuation of ongoing learning mobility activities under the Erasmus+ programme established by Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013, in the context of the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the Union <sup>(1)</sup>.
- (2) Protocol 31 to the EEA Agreement should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

The following indent shall be added in paragraph 2n of Article 4 of Protocol 31 to the EEA Agreement:

‘ **32019 R 0499**: Regulation (EU) 2019/499 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 March 2019 laying down provisions for the continuation of ongoing learning mobility activities under the Erasmus+ programme established by Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013, in the context of the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the Union (OJ L 85I, 27.3.2019, p. 32).’

*Article 2*

This Decision shall enter into force on 15 June 2019, or on the day following the last notification under Article 103(1) of the EEA Agreement \*, whichever is the later.

*Article 3*This Decision shall be published in the EEA Section of, and in the EEA Supplement to, the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
