DECISION NO 3/2012 OF THE COMMITTEE ON MUTUAL RECOGNITION IN RELATION TO CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT ESTABLISHED UNDER ANNEX I TO THE CONVENTION

Adopted by the Committee on 29 November 2012

MUTUAL RECOGNITION IN RELATION TO CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT

THE COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement of 21 June 1999 between the European Community and the Swiss Confederation on mutual recognition in relation to conformity assessment between the European Community and the Swiss Confederation as amended, hereinafter referred to as “the Swiss-EU MRA”,

Having regard to the Member States’ endeavour to regularly update the Convention in order to take account of developments under the Agreement on the European Economic Area and the Swiss-EU MRA,

Noting that a new Chapter 19 on Cableway installations has been introduced in Annex 1 of the Swiss-EU MRA by Decision 1/2011 of the Committee established under the Agreement between the European Community and the Swiss Confederation on mutual recognition in relation to conformity assessment of 20 December 2011,

Having regard to the necessity to amend the scope of Annex I of the EFTA Convention to fully reflect the changes made in the Swiss-EU MRA,

Having regard to Article 53(4) of the Convention,

Having regard to Protocol 12 of the EEA Agreement,

DECIDES:

1. Annex I to the Convention shall be amended as follows:
 - a) In Article 3(1) the words “1/2010 of 18 October 2010” shall be replaced by “1/2011 of 20 December 2011”.

- b) In footnote 3 to Article 3 the words “OJ L 46, 19.2.2011, p. 51” shall be replaced by “OJ L 80, 20.3.2012, p. 31”.
- c) In the list of product sectors at the beginning of Appendix 1 the following shall be added after point 18. Biocidal products:

‘19. Cableway installations’

- d) The following shall be inserted at the end of Appendix 1:

‘19. CABLEWAY INSTALLATIONS

EEA EFTA States

Iceland: The Ministry of Welfare

Liechtenstein: Amt für Volkswirtschaft (Office of Economic Affairs)

Norway: The Ministry of Transport and Communications

Switzerland: Federal Office of Transport

- 2. This Decision shall enter into force immediately.
