CONCLUSIONS ON STANDING COMMITTEE ACTIVITIES

- Closely coordinate with the EU in response to Russia's war of aggression against Ukraine and take necessary action to ensure a level playing field and preserve the coherence of the Internal Market.
 - Make efforts to ensure the swift incorporation of pending EEA-relevant EU acts and assess internal processing methods with a view to further reducing the backlog of legal acts awaiting incorporation.
 - Make sure that stakeholders from the EEA EFTA States are fully involved in all activities of the relevant EU programmes for the 2021-2027 period.
 - Engage at an early stage in the decision-shaping process of EEA-relevant EU legislation, with a particular focus on initiatives linked to the green and digital transition.
 - Undertake outreach activities to strengthen knowledge of the EEA Agreement in the EU and the EEA EFTA States.
