Decision shaping by the EEA EFTA States

The EEA EFTA States take on board EU legislation through the EEA Agreement, but the Agreement does not grant us voting (decision making) rights on the EU side.

- Objective: Contribute to the development of EU legislation and policy/strategy up until they are formally adopted
- Means available to the EEA EFTA States:
 - Experts' participation in Commission Experts Groups and Committees, but without the right to vote
 - II. Contributing to the management of EU programmes
 - III. Contributing to the work of EU agencies
 - IV. EEA EFTA Comments on new policies and Commission proposals for legislation

EEA EFTA Comment

- Common position paper agreed by the governments of the EEA EFTA States to raise issues of importance to them
- Issued during consultation phase, after adoption or throughout co-decision procedures
- Submitted to Secretariat-General, relevant DGs, European Parliament and current/incoming Council Presidency

EEA EFTA Comment

on the Commission Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on contestable and fair markets in the digital sector (Digital Markets Act) - COM/2020/842

1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The EEA Agreement extends the Single Market to the EEA EFTA States (Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway). Continued incorporation of relevant EU legislation into the Agreement ensures legal homogeneity throughout the EEA.
- The EEA EFTA States welcome the proposal for a Regulation on contestable and fair markets in the digital sector (Digital Markets Act, DMA). As some large platforms currently act as gatekeepers in digital markets, the EEA EFTA States fully support the overall objective of the proposal to harmonise rules in support of contestable and fair digital markets in the EEA.
- Concerning the designation of gatekeepers, the EEA EFTA States are of the view that
 the thresholds put forward by the Commission would best serve the proposal's
 objectives, while not imposing an unnecessary regulatory burden on smaller platforms.
- The EEA EFTA States acknowledge that digital gatekeepers and platforms differ substantially in their characteristics and business models. Therefore, as Articles 5 and 6 apply to all gatekeepers, caution should be shown if the lists of obligations were to be extended during the EU legislative process.



Process to develop EEA EFTA Comment

Agreement in the EFTA Working Group to develop EEA EFTA Comment First draft prepared by Member State or EFTA Secretariat Consultations on draft with Working Group Consultation with EEA EFTA Missions and Heads of Delegations of relevant Subcommittee Approval by Heads of Delegations of relevant Subcommittee Formal approval by the Standing Committee Submission to the EU side with letter of transmittal from Chair of the Standing Committee



Alignment with EU legislative process

- Accommodate for milestones in the EU legislative process
- Monitor developments in Council and EP throughout the legislative process
