DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 25/94 of 2 December 1994

amending Annex VII (Mutual Recognition of Professional Qualifications) to the EEA Agreement

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, as adjusted by the Protocol Adjusting the Agreement on the European Economic Area, hereinafter referred to as the Agreement, and in particular Article 98 thereof,

Whereas Annex VII to the Agreement was amended by Decision of the EEA Joint Committee No 7/94 of 21 March 1994 amending Protocol 47 and certain Annexes to the EEA Agreement (1);

Whereas Commission Directive 94/38/EC of 26 July 1994 (²) amending Annexes C and D of Council Directive 92/51/EEC of 18 June 1992 on a second general system for the recognition of professional education and training to supplement Directive 89/48/EEC is to be incorporated into the Agreement,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

- 1. The following shall be added in Annex VII to the Agreement in point 1a (Council Directive 92/51/EEC) before the adaptations:

- 2. The following adaptation shall be added after adaptation (b):
- "(c) The additions to Annex C listed in adaptation (b) are to be read together with the list included in Annex II to Commission Directive 94/38/EC.".
