# DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 100/2010

### of 1 October 2010

# amending Annex II (Technical regulations, standards, testing and certification) to the EEA Agreement

# THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, as amended by the Protocol adjusting the Agreement on the European Economic Area, hereinafter referred to as 'the Agreement', and in particular Article 98 thereof,

#### Whereas:

- (1) Annex II to the Agreement was amended by Decision of the EEA Joint Committee No 83/2010 of 2 July 2010 <sup>1</sup>.
- (2) Commission Regulation (EU) No 178/2010 of 2 March 2010 amending Regulation (EC) No 401/2006 as regards groundnuts (peanuts), other oilseeds, tree nuts, apricot kernels, liquorice and vegetable oil<sup>2</sup> is to be incorporated into the Agreement.
- (3) This Decision is not to apply to Liechtenstein,

# HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

## Article 1

The following shall be added in point 54zzzl (Commission Regulation (EC) No 401/2006) of Chapter XII of Annex II to the Agreement:

### Article 2
