# DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 84/2011

## of 1 July 2011

amending Annex XVIII (Health and safety at work, labour law, and equal treatment for men and women) to the EEA Agreement

## THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, as amended by the Protocol adjusting the Agreement on the European Economic Area, hereinafter referred to as 'the Agreement', and in particular Article 98 thereof,

#### Whereas:

- (1) Annex XVIII to the Agreement was amended by Decision of the EEA Joint Committee No 41/2011 of 1 April 2011<sup>1</sup>.
- (2) Directive 2010/41/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 July 2010 on the application of the principle of equal treatment between men and women engaged in an activity in a self-employed capacity and repealing Council Directive 86/613/EEC<sup>2</sup> is to be incorporated into the Agreement.
- (3) Directive 2010/41/EU repeals Council Directive 86/613/EEC<sup>3</sup>, which is incorporated into the Agreement, and which is therefore to be repealed with effect from 5 August 2012.

### HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

#### Article 1

The text of point 21 (Council Directive 86/613/EEC) of Annex XVIII to the Agreement shall be replaced with effect from 5 August 2012 by the following:

**'32010 L 0041**: Directive 2010/41/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 July 2010 on the application of the principle of equal treatment between men and women engaged in an activity in a self-employed capacity and repealing Council Directive 86/613/EEC (OJ L 180, 15.7.2010, p. 1).'

This Decision shall enter into force on 2 July 2011, provided that all the notifications under Article 103(1) of the Agreement have been made to the EEA Joint Committee\*.
