

**DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 215/2018****of 26 October 2018****amending Annex X (Services in general) and Annex XVIII (Health and safety at work, labour law, and equal treatment for men and women) to the EEA Agreement [2021/498]**

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area ('the EEA Agreement'), and in particular Article 98 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Directive 2014/67/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 May 2014 on the enforcement of Directive 96/71/EC concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of services and amending Regulation (EU) No 1024/2012 on administrative cooperation through the Internal Market Information System ('the IMI Regulation') <sup>(1)</sup> is to be incorporated into the EEA Agreement.
- (2) Annexes X and XVIII to the EEA Agreement should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

The following indent is added in point 3 (Regulation (EU) No 1024/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council) of Annex X to the EEA Agreement:

‘— **32014 L 0067**: Directive 2014/67/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 May 2014 (OJ L 159, 28.5.2014, p. 11).’

*Article 2*

The following is inserted after point 30a (Commission Decision 2009/17/EC) of Annex XVIII to the EEA Agreement:

‘30b. **32014 L 0067**: Directive 2014/67/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 May 2014 on the enforcement of Directive 96/71/EC concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of services and amending Regulation (EU) No 1024/2012 on administrative cooperation through the Internal Market Information System ('the IMI Regulation') (OJ L 159, 28.5.2014, p. 11).

The provisions of the Directive shall, for the purposes of this Agreement, be read with the following adaptation:

In Article 4(3)(c), as regards the EFTA States, the words “according to Regulation (EC) No 593/2008 (Rome I) and/or the Rome Convention” shall not apply.’

*Article 3*

The text of Directive 2014/67/EU in the Icelandic and Norwegian languages, to be published in the EEA Supplement to the *Official Journal of the European Union*, shall be authentic.

*Article 4*

This Decision shall enter into force on 27 October 2018, provided that all the notifications under Article 103(1) of the EEA Agreement have been made (\*).
