

**DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 323/2022****of 9 December 2022****amending Annex VII (Recognition of professional qualifications) to the EEA Agreement [2023/1265]**

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area ("the EEA Agreement"), and in particular Article 98 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907 of 14 March 2019 establishing a Common Training Test for ski instructors under Article 49b of Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the recognition of the professional qualifications <sup>(1)</sup>, as corrected by OJ L 38, 11.2.2020, p. 39, is to be incorporated into the EEA Agreement.
- (2) Annex VII to the EEA Agreement should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

The following point is inserted after point 1c (Directive (EU) 2018/958 of the European Parliament and of the Council) of Annex VII to the EEA Agreement:

- '1d. **32019 R 0907**: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907 of 14 March 2019 establishing a Common Training Test for ski instructors under Article 49b of Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the recognition of the professional qualifications (OJ L 145, 4.6.2019, p. 7), as corrected by OJ L 38, 11.2.2020, p. 39.'

*Article 2*

The text of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907, as corrected by OJ L 38, 11.2.2020, p. 39, in the Icelandic and Norwegian languages, to be published in the EEA Supplement to the *Official Journal of the European Union*, shall be authentic.

*Article 3*

This Decision shall enter into force on 10 December 2022, provided that all the notifications under Article 103(1) of the EEA Agreement have been made \*.

*Article 4*

This Decision shall be published in the EEA Section of, and in the EEA Supplement to, the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
