# amending Annex II (Technical regulations, standards, testing and certification) to the EEA Agreement

# THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area ("the EEA Agreement"), and in particular Article 98 thereof,

### Whereas:

- (1) Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2023/2619 of 24 November 2023 postponing the expiry date of the approval of hydrochloric acid for use in biocidal products of product-type 2 in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>1</sup> is to be incorporated into the EEA Agreement.
- (2) Annex II to the EEA Agreement should therefore be amended accordingly,

#### HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

# Article 1

The following point is inserted after point 12zzzzzzzzzz (Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2023/2672) of Chapter XV of Annex II to the EEA Agreement:
