

APPENDIX 1 TO ANNEX I

PRODUCT-SPECIFIC RULES

SECTION I

INTERPRETATIVE NOTES

1. The product-specific rules (PSR) of origin set out in this Appendix are based on HS 2022. The first column of the list contains the Harmonized System (HS) code and the description, where appropriate. The rules are specified in the second column.
2. The PSR may be fulfilled by operations in more than one company, within an EFTA State or MERCOSUR if these operations, taken together, fulfil the requirements of Annex I (Rules of Origin).
3. A PSR set out in this Appendix represents the minimum amount of working or processing required to be carried out on non-originating materials for the final product to achieve originating status. A greater amount of working or processing than that required by the rule shall also confer originating status.
4. Reference to weight in a PSR means the net weight, which is the weight of a material or a product, not including the weight of packaging.
5. If a PSR in the list specifies that a product may be manufactured from more than one non-originating material, any one or more non-originating materials may be used. It does not require that all be used.
6. If a PSR in the list specifies that a product must be manufactured from a particular material, the condition does not prevent the use of other non-originating materials in addition.
7. If a PSR excludes non-originating materials classified in certain chapters, headings, or sub-headings, such materials must be originating for the products to qualify as originating.
8. If a product, which has acquired originating status by fulfilling the conditions set out in the list, is used as material in the manufacture of another product, the conditions applicable to the final product do not apply to that material. No account shall be taken of the non-originating components of that material.
9. “Manufacture from non-originating materials of any heading”, non-originating materials of any heading, even non-originating materials of the same description and heading as the final product may be used, subject to any specific limitations which may also be contained in the PSR.

10. For the purposes of PSR, the following abbreviations apply¹:
- (a) “CC” means manufacture from non-originating materials of any Chapter, except that of the product; this means that all non-originating materials used in the manufacture of the product must undergo a change in tariff classification at the two-digit level (i.e. a change in Chapter) of the HS.
 - (b) “CTH” means manufacture from non-originating materials of any heading, except that of the product; this means that all non-originating materials used in the manufacture of the product must undergo a change in tariff classification at the four-digit level (i.e. a change in heading) of the HS.
 - (c) “CTSH” means manufacture from non-originating materials of any subheading, except that of the product; this means that all non-originating materials used in the manufacture of the product must undergo a change in tariff classification at the six-digit level (i.e. a change in sub-heading) of the HS.
11. Subject to Annexes II, III, IV and V (Schedules of Tariff Commitments on Goods), the products mentioned in the list shall benefit from preferential treatment.

¹ For greater certainty, if a requirement of a change in tariff classification provides for exception for a change from certain Chapters, headings or subheadings, none of the non-originating materials of those Chapters, headings or subheadings may be used, individually or jointly.

SECTION II

NOTE REFERRING TO AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

Agricultural products falling within Chapters 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12 and heading 2401 which are grown or harvested in the territory of an EFTA State or MERCOSUR shall be treated as originating in the territory of that country, even if grown from seeds, bulbs, rootstock, cuttings, grafts, shoots, buds, or other live parts of plants imported from another country.

SECTION III

NOTES REFERRING TO CHAPTERS 27 TO 39

1. For the purposes of PSR of origin:
 - (a) “biotechnological process” means:
 - (i) biological or biotechnological culturing (including cell culture), hybridisation or genetic modification of micro-organisms (bacteria, viruses (including phages) etc.) or human, animal or plant cells; and
 - (ii) production, isolation or purification of cellular or intercellular structures (such as isolated genes, gene fragments and plasmids), or fermentation.
 - (b) “change in particle size” means, for the purposes of chapters 30 to 32: deliberate and controlled modification in particle size of a product, other than by merely crushing or pressing, resulting in a product having a defined particle size, defined particle size distribution or defined surface area, which are relevant to the purposes of the resulting product and have different physical or chemical characteristics from the non-originating input materials.
 - (c) “chemical reaction” means a process, including a biochemical process, which results in a molecule with a new structure by breaking intramolecular bonds and by forming new intramolecular bonds, or by altering the spatial arrangement of the molecule. A chemical reaction may also be expressed by a change of the “CAS number”. It does not mean:
 - (i) dissolving in water or other solvents;
 - (ii) elimination of solvents including solvent water; or
 - (iii) addition or elimination of water of crystallisation.
 - (d) “isomer separation” means, for the purposes of chapters 28 to 32 and chapter 35: isolation or separation of isomers from a mixture of isomers.
 - (e) “production of standard materials” means, for the purposes of chapters 28 to 32, chapter 35 and chapter 38: production of preparations suitable for analytical, calibrating or referencing uses having precise degrees of purity or proportions which are certified by the manufacturer.
 - (f) “purification” means:
 - (i) purification of a product resulting in the elimination of 80% of the content of existing impurities;
 - (ii) reduction or elimination of impurities resulting in a product suitable for one or more of the following applications:
 - (aa) pharmaceutical, medicinal, cosmetic, veterinary, or food grade substances;

- (bb) chemical products and reagents for analytical, diagnostic or laboratory uses;
- (cc) elements and components for use in micro-elements;
- (dd) specialised optical uses;
- (ee) non-toxic uses for health and safety;
- (ff) biotechnical use;
- (gg) carriers used in a separation process; or
- (hh) nuclear grade uses.

SECTION IV

NOTE REFERRING TO CHAPTERS 50-63

Definitions

1. “man-made staple fibres” means synthetic or artificial filament tow, staple fibres or waste, of headings 55.01 to 55.07.
2. “natural fibres” means horsehair of heading 05.03, silk of headings 50.02 and 50.03, as well as wool-fibres and fine or coarse animal hair of headings 51.01 to 51.05, cotton fibres of headings 52.01 to 52.03, and other vegetable fibres of headings 53.01 to 53.05.
3. “natural fibres” means fibres other than artificial or synthetic fibres. It is restricted to the stages before spinning takes place, including waste, and, unless otherwise specified, includes fibres which have been carded, combed or otherwise processed, but not spun.
4. “printing” means a technique by which an objectively assessed function, like colour, design, technical performance, is given to a textile substrate with a permanent character, using screen, roller, digital or transfer techniques.
5. “printing (as standalone operation)” means a technique by which an objectively assessed function, like colour, design, technical performance, is given to a textile substrate with a permanent character, using screen, roller, digital or transfer techniques combined with at least two preparatory/finishing operations (such as scouring, bleaching, mercerising, heat setting, raising, calendaring, shrink resistance processing, permanent finishing, decatizing, impregnating, mending and burling), provided that the value of all the non-originating materials used does not exceed 50% of the ex-works price (EXW) of the product.
6. “textile pulp”, “chemical materials” and “paper-making materials” means the non-originating materials, not classified in Chapters 50 to 63, which can be used to manufacture artificial, synthetic or paper fibres or yarns.

Tolerances applicable to products containing two or more basic textile materials

1. The conditions set out in the second column shall not be applied to any non-originating basic textile materials (excluding elastomeric yarns) used in the manufacture of the products of Chapters 50 to 63 and which, taken together, represent 10 % or less of the total weight of all the basic textile materials used.
2. However, the tolerance mentioned in paragraph 1 may only be applied to mixed products which have been made from two or more basic textile materials.

The following materials are considered basic textile materials:

- silk,
- wool,
- coarse animal hair,
- fine animal hair,

- horsehair,
- cotton,
- paper-making materials and paper,
- flax,
- true hemp,
- jute and other textile bast fibres,
- sisal and other textile fibres of the genus Agave,
- coconut, abaca, ramie and other vegetable textile fibres,
- synthetic man-made filaments,
- artificial man-made filaments,
- current-conducting filaments,
- synthetic man-made staple fibres of polypropylene,
- synthetic man-made staple fibres of polyester,
- synthetic man-made staple fibres of polyamide,
- synthetic man-made staple fibres of polyacrylonitrile,
- synthetic man-made staple fibres of polyimide,
- synthetic man-made staple fibres of polytetrafluoroethylene,
- synthetic man-made staple fibres of polyphenylene sulphide,
- synthetic man-made staple fibres of polyvinyl chloride,
- other synthetic man-made staple fibres,
- artificial man-made staple fibres of viscose,
- other artificial man-made staple fibres,
- yarn made of polyurethane segmented with flexible segments of polyether, whether or not gimped,
- yarn made of polyurethane segmented with flexible segments of polyester, whether or not gimped,
- products of heading 56.05 (metallised yarn) incorporating strip consisting of a core of aluminium foil or of a core of plastic film whether or not coated with aluminium powder, of a width not exceeding 5 mm, sandwiched by means of a transparent or coloured adhesive between two layers of plastic film,
- other products of heading 56.05.

Example:

A yarn, of heading 52.05, made from cotton fibres of heading 52.03 and synthetic staple fibres of heading 55.06, is a mixed yarn. Therefore, non-originating synthetic staple fibres which do not satisfy the origin-rules may be used, provided that their total weight does not exceed 10% of the weight of the yarn.

Example:

A woollen fabric, of heading 51.12, made from woollen yarn of heading 51.07 and synthetic yarn of staple fibres of heading 55.09, is a mixed fabric. Therefore, synthetic yarn which does not satisfy the origin-rules, or woollen yarn which does not satisfy the origin-rules, or a combination of the two, may be used, provided that their total weight does not exceed 10% of the weight of the fabric.

Example:

Tufted textile fabric, of heading 58.02, made from cotton yarn of heading 52.05 and cotton fabric of heading 52.10, is only a mixed product if the cotton fabric is itself a mixed fabric made from yarns classified in two separate headings, or if the cotton yarns used are themselves mixtures.

Example:

If the tufted textile fabric concerned had been made from cotton yarn of heading 52.05 and synthetic fabric of heading 54.07, then, obviously, the yarns used are two separate basic textile materials and the tufted textile fabric is, accordingly, a mixed product.

3. In the case of products of Chapters 50 to 63 incorporating “yarn made of polyurethane segmented with flexible segments of polyether, whether or not gimped”, this tolerance is 20% in respect of this yarn.

4. In the case of products of Chapters 50 to 63 incorporating “strip consisting of a core of aluminium foil or of a core of plastic film whether or not coated with aluminium powder, of a width not exceeding 5 mm, sandwiched by means of a transparent or coloured adhesive between two layers of plastic film”, this tolerance is 30% in respect of this strip.

Other tolerances applicable to certain textile products

1. Textile materials (with the exception of linings and interlinings, elastomeric yarns and sewing threads) which do not satisfy the rule set out in the list in the second column for the made-up product concerned, may be used, provided that they are classified in a heading other than that of the product and that their value does not exceed 8% of the EXW of the product.

2. Without prejudice of the following paragraph, non-originating materials which are not classified within Chapters 50 to 63 may be used freely in the manufacture of textile products, whether or not they contain textiles.

Example:

If a rule in the list provides that, for a particular textile item (such as trousers), yarn must be used, this does not prevent the use of metal items, such as buttons, because buttons are not classified within Chapters 50 to 63. For the same reason, it does not prevent the use of slide fasteners, even though slide-fasteners normally contain textiles.

3. Where a percentage-rule applies, the value of non-originating materials which are not classified within Chapters 50 to 63 must be taken into account when calculating the value of the non-originating materials incorporated.
