No. 1 of 2018

(Adopted on 21 November 2018)

AMENDMENT TO PROTOCOL A TO THE AGREEMENT  
REFERRED TO IN SUB-PARAGRAPH 1(b) OF ARTICLE 2  
PROCESSED AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

THE JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to discussions at the eighth Joint EFTA-Israel Committee meeting held in Jerusalem on 23 November 2011, as well as subsequent exchanges of views, on the review of Protocol A to the Agreement between the EFTA States and Israel (hereinafter referred to as “the Agreement”),

Having regard to Article 6 of Protocol A providing that the Parties shall review and decide on possible changes to the product coverage of Protocol A,

Having regard to Article 30 of the Agreement, empowering the Joint Committee to amend the Protocols to the Agreement,

DECIDES:

1. The text of Protocol A to the Agreement shall be replaced with the text as set out in the Annex to this Decision.
  2. This Decision shall enter into force on the first day of the third month after the instruments of ratification or acceptance have been deposited by the Parties with the Depository, which shall notify the Parties.
  3. The Secretary-General of the European Free Trade Association shall deposit the text of this Decision with the Depository.
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# **PROTOCOL A**

PROCESSED AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

Article 1

1. In order to take account of differences in the cost of the agricultural raw materials incorporated into the products referred to in Article 2, the Agreement does not preclude:
  - (a) the levying, upon import, of a fixed duty;
  - (b) the application of measures adopted upon export.
2. The duty, levied upon import, shall be based on, but not exceed, the differences between the domestic price and the world market price of the agricultural raw materials incorporated into the products concerned.

Article 2

1. Taking into account the provisions laid down in Article 1, Norway and Switzerland shall accord for products listed in Table 1, originating in Israel, treatment no less favourable than that accorded to the European Union.
2. The treatment accorded to Israel by Iceland will be the same as Iceland accorded to the European Union on 1 January 2015.

Article 3

For products listed in Table 2, originating in an EFTA State, Israel shall accord treatment as set out in the Table.

Article 4

1. The EFTA States shall publish import duties applicable to processed agricultural products on the EFTA website.

2. Each Party may raise any issue related to the price compensation measures. Such issues will be promptly discussed by experts from Israel and the EFTA State or States concerned in order to avoid trade distortions that may result from the implementation of such measures. If no mutually satisfactory solution has been reached, the Joint Committee shall meet at the request of any of the Parties concerned, and within 90 days.

3. The Joint Committee may set up a working party in accordance with paragraph 5 of Article 27 of the Agreement to discuss a possible solution to the problem. The working party shall be composed of experts from the Parties responsible for price compensation measures.

#### Article 5

The Parties shall periodically review the development of their trade in products covered by this Protocol. In the light of these reviews and taking into account the arrangements between the Parties and the European Union or in the WTO, the Parties shall decide on possible changes to the product coverage of this Protocol, as well as on a possible development of the measures applied under Article 1 of this Protocol.
