CONCLUSIONS ON EFTA INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL RELATIONS

Relations between the EFTA States

- Continue to adapt the EFTA Convention and its annexes in accordance with Member States' needs;
- Further strengthen and deepen cooperation between the EFTA States on trade matters.

EFTA free trade agreements and other trade relations with third countries

Free trade negotiations

- Finalise negotiations with Mercosur;
- Work towards the conclusion of negotiations on free trade agreements (FTAs) with Kosovo, Malaysia, and Thailand;
- Advance negotiations with Vietnam.

Management and development of existing free trade agreements

- Work towards the conclusion of a digital economy agreement (DEA) with Singapore;
- Work towards the conclusion of a modernised FTA with Ukraine;
- Prepare for the implementation, especially of the new chapter on investment promotion and cooperation, of the recently signed FTA with India;

- Continue to monitor FTA chapters on trade and sustainable development, and hold joint committee meetings with relevant partners;
- Continue to modernise FTAs.

Potential partners and other activities

- Sign/adopt a joint declaration on economic cooperation with ASEAN;
- Identify opportunities for structured dialogue with relevant trading nations or blocs;
- Identify opportunities to engage with partners on the African continent.

Horizontal issues

- Continue to foster the transparency of FTA processes, including through close and regular dialogue and consultation with the EFTA Advisory Bodies;
 - Continue to deepen and widen the EFTA FTA Monitor with FTA partners, the EU, the UK and intra-EFTA – and strengthen analysis of preference under-utilisation;
 - Discuss and prepare the implementation of the SME Chapter;
 - Implement the revised Pan-Euro-Mediterranean (PEM) Convention in FTAs with PEM partners;
 - Identify and carry out technical cooperation activities.
